## Comparing Moses to Revelation

**"Moses day" Passover:**  
 God showed the Egyptians that He reigns over the kingdoms of this world. First born of Egypt died, while Israel leaves the kingdom of Egypt with great reward. Israel heads out to be a new kingdom under God himself.

## Comparing Moses to Revelation

**"Moses day" Unleavened Bread:**  
 Cleanse your house of leaven which was a picture of sins. The new bread will be free of "sin".

## Comparing Moses to Revelation

**"Moses day" First Fruits:**  
 When you come into the new land, wave the firstfruits of the harvest before the LORD.

## Comparing Moses to Revelation

**"Moses day" Pentecost:**  
 After 50 days, God came down on the mountain to Moses and the people. God offered Himself to man or laws to govern themselves.

## Comparing Moses to Revelation

**"Moses day" Trumpets:**  
 They are given a simple law, blow the trumpet. Trumpet blowing is a sign that something is about to happen (warning, war, attack is coming...)

## Comparing Moses to Revelation

**"Moses day" Day of Atonement:**  
 A day of judgement of yourself. Only time in Lev. 23 that God says He will destroy anyone that does any work.

**"Revelation" Passover:**  
 The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. Wrath is come, dead are judged. Reward to the servants the prophets, and to the saints.

**"Revelation" Unleavened Bread:**  
 The third part of heaven (the corrupt government) is being cleansed out of heaven. There is a man child in proverbial oven (baby in the womb) and this one is free of sin and brings salvation and strength. The bread from heaven is coming forth.

**"Revelation" First Fruits:**  
 When the woman brings forth the man child, he will be the firstfruits. Jesus is the firstfruits. Jesus coming out of the grave is the firstfruit. Side note: Is the "earth" - the "woman"? The earth is clothed with the sun and moon, and the 12 chosen by God were sitting on the earth like crowns.

**"Revelation" Pentecost:**  
 God says "It is done." He has offered Himself to man three times and each time they chose incorrectly. **Man's choice is highlighted**  
 In the garden: Tree of Life or **Tree of the knowledge of good and evil**.  
 On the mountain: God's presents with man or **to be ruled by man**.  
 In the flesh: Jesus or **Barabbas (a robber: John 18:40)**  
 NOTE: Man received what he asked for each time.

**"Revelation" Trumpets:**  
 Jesus says "Surely, I come quickly."  
 The law is: don't "add to" or "take away" the words of this book of prophecy.  
 Jesus fills full the law so don't add to him or take away from Him.  
 NOTE: Out of the seven section on this page that are out of the book of Revelation, this is the only section that has a law for all men to follow.

**"Revelation" Day of Atonement:**  
 Great white throne judgement. You are judged based on your "works". You better not have any works or you will be destroyed. Remember, the law is don't add to or take away from Jesus.

## Comparing Moses to Revelation

**"Moses day" Tabernacle:**  
 Saw judgement of Egypt. Traveled in the wilderness in temporary dwellings. Waiting for a permanent place to live. Went up and down seven mountains. Received the "seven" as God and then chose the ten commandments. Moses finally got to see the real promise land on his last trip up the mountain.

**"Revelation" Tabernacle:**  
 Seven kings and ten kings. Carried away into the wilderness. Judgement of the great whore. **It is done** and the earth is made smooth again. The promise land is restored on earth.
